Gov. Obiano reiterate call for a state of emergency on erosion in Anambra State.

Gov. Willie Obiano of Anambra has again called on the Federal Government to declare a state of emergency on erosion menace in the state. The Governor made the call during his visit to the erosion site along MINAJ Road, Obosi layout in Idemili North Local Government Area of the state. "As a state, we cannot handle these challenges alone and still carry on with other responsibilities. "We are appealing to the Federal Government to declare a state of emergency on erosion menace in Anambra," Obiano said. The governor ordered the IDC Constriction Ltd., to immediately commence work at the site to prevent the erosion from cutting the road. He expressed regret that erosion menace had consistently posed a great problem to the people of the state and called on international donor agencies to come to the aid of the State.

World Bank Holds FY2018 SPPR for South-East and South-South Regions.



The World Bank on September 14th and 15th held the 2018 Fiscal Year State Portfolio Performance Review; at Uyo Akwa Ibom State. The State Portfolio Performance Review covers World Bank Assisted Projects implemented in the South-South and South-East regions.

Anambra State Commissioner for Economic Planning and Budget Development Mr. Mark Okoye who is coordinating the state's Portfolio of Bank Assisted Projects, on behalf of the State Governor presented a consolidated portfolio status report of the performance of all World Bank Assisted projects in the State; highlighting ways to improve portfolio performance at the State level which includes quick resolution of bottlenecks and enhanced capacity to access funds.

The World Bank Safeguards implementation support mission recently held a 3 days clinic on safeguard issues across the NEWMAP implementation states. Led by Dr. Chudi Okafor and Mr. Lucky Erhaze, Senior World Bank Safeguard Specialists, The Mission placed emphasis on project social risk management, identified constraints likely to affect project implementation and advice on possible solutions. It also worked on capacity assessment and participation at state and local levels as well as meeting with vulnerable groups to assess their ability to use planned project resources and assess compliance with safeguards obligations.
